- All participants must adhere to the relevant stage task, budget and cooking time.
- Participants must complete all paperwork to deadlines and supply full details as required, and comply with all rules
- All participants must comply with FutureChef's Health & Safety Guidelines whilst taking part in the event. Refer to separate Health & Safety Guidelines document online under My Courses and clicking on FutureChef Competition
- By entering the FutureChef programme, you hereby declare that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete
- By entering this programme, each participant grants Springboard the right to reproduce, publish or exhibit their recipes and photographs, in whole or in part, without charge or compensation
- Springboard requires the completion of a signed media release form. This will be supplied by Springboard to be completed by parents/guardians to allow for the publishing of photographs of participants and their recipes and images of their dishes through Springboards social media and marketing channels including the FutureChef Website. When announcing competitors online, First name and school will be published. Should there be any reason as to why images or the name of the participant and school cannot be published, please let Springboard know as soon as possible
