

FutureChef Competition The Rules

- The competition is open to persons in Year 9-11(England & Wales), S3-5 (Scotland) and Year 10 -12 (Northern Ireland) by 1st March 2024. The participants must not be undertaking an apprenticeship.
- All participants must adhere to the relevant stage task, budget and cooking time.
- Participants must complete all paperwork to deadlines and supply full details and required and comply with all rules.
- All participants at the Local/Regional/National Finals must comply with the Health and Safety Guidelines given at the start of that heat by a college representative and/or Springboard Representative. For school heats all participants much comply with the health and safety guidelines set by their school.
- By entering the FutureChef programme, you hereby declare that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete.
- Springboard requires the completion of a signed media release consent. This will be supplied by Springboard to be completed by parents/guardians to allow for the publishing of photographs of participants and their recipes and images of their dishes through Springboards social media and marketing channels including the FutureChef website.
- Once consent is received, each participant grants Springboard the right to reproduce, publish or exhibit their recipes and photographs, in whole or in part, without charge or compensation
- When announcing competitors online, First name and school will be published . Should there be any reason as to why images or the name of the participant and school can not be published, please let Springboard know as soon as possible.
- It is important to understand that if you withdraw consent for your child's image to be used or shared in the future, it may not be possible to remove images that have already been published or distributed.

- We fully welcome, and indeed encourage, the re-entry of competitors, and recognise the right to competition entry for any young person that meets the entry criteria.

- In the event of any dispute regarding the rules, programme notice, conduct, results and all other matters relating to the competition or programme, the decision of Springboard shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.

- Springboard reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition, or these Rules at any time without prior notice. Any changes will be communicated as soon as possible.
- The cost of ingredients and travel for school heat , local final, regional final will be met by the school/participant.
- At National Final stage, practice ingredients should be covered by school/participant etc.
- Ingredients will be supplied by Springboard on the day of the National Final.
- All reasonable travel expenses incurred by National finalists and two supporting members of their party to and from the National Final ONLY, will be met by Springboard, provided receipts are supplied
- Spring board reserves the right to disqualify any participant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the participant has breached any of these competition rules.
